We will divide up the weekend's time among all who attend and would like to participate. Each attendee will have a choice to make regarding how they use their allotted time. You can:
- A) Give a presentation on a topic close to your heart and in some way related to spiritual evolution, philosophy, metaphysics, etc.
 - B) Choose a topic for group study. In this case, Carla will compile excerpts from the L/L Research Transcript Library relevant to your topic for study. A handout containing these excerpts will be given to each in attendance. During your allotted time, the circle will read the excerpts on the chosen topic, interrupting the reading whenever the attendees want to question or discuss the topic set forth.
 - C) Choose to facilitate a group discussion. In this case, you may decide to facilitate a group discussion with questions you pose to the circle, rather than give a presentation or read from compiled excerpts. You would act as a moderator for the discussion in this case. Again, Carla will provide an arsenal of readings to fuel discussion.
 - D) You can choose not to have a block of time allotted to you if you would like to participate only as a listener and do not have a current topic of special interest to you. However we hope that you will take advantage of the time offered. It's a great boost to be able to work with the group and sharing points of view in a supportive atmosphere is the focus of the weekend!
