Greetings of this beautiful spring from L/L Research in Kentucky. It is Derby season here! The thoroughbreds are running at Churchill Downs while the fruit trees, bushes and bulbs are blooming everywhere!

Channeling Intensives: L/L Research is currently planning three Gatherings. The first comes up next weekend. We are hosting a small Channeling Intensive Make-up Gathering over Derby weekend. This session is to accommodate the four people who wished to attend Channeling Intensive 1, but could not because of schedule conflicts or because the seating was filled.

The attendees have done their homework, which was to write their "Who Am I" essays and to listen to all of the teaching sessions from CI-1. That's a big job, but in order for us to move through the material and get them ready to attend CI-2, it needs to be done. They have all taken notes as they have listened. We will begin by answering all the questions raised as the attendees listened to the recordings.

We will then work on creating a workroom, finding one's gatekeeper and visualizing one's guidance system. Lastly, we will practice the tuning process and have at least one channeling circle.

It should be a very enjoyable weekend for all of us!

Just one month later, on the first weekend in June, L/L Research will hold Channeling Intensive 2. It will be a very full house, here at Camelot! The attendees are bringing essays on "Why I Want to Channel", and we will share those essays. We will have several study periods in order to read and discuss together what the Confederation has to say about channeling. And we will continue to hold Channeling Circles and subsequent Q and A sessions.

These Channeling Intensives are called "intensive" for a good reason: they are intense! However they are aimed towards developing a channeling circle that can offer the channeling as a service, so the meeting is all about focus.

Homecoming: Our third planned Gathering this summer is Homecoming 2008. We will hold it here at Camelot. Believe it or not, it is already filling up fast, so please write to Gary at contact@llresearch.org and secure your seat in the circle of seeking as soon as you are sure you wish to attend.

This year, our curriculum will be attendee-driven. Each attendee will bring with him a presentation upon the subject he wants to discuss with the group. Over the weekend we will listen to the attendees' presentations and discuss the subjects raised. The presentations can be very short, just a starter for discussion, or they can be more extended offerings which bring in the factors of the subject which the attendees have considered.

If this agenda appeals to you, or if you simply want to come home, spiritually speaking, and join others who are interested in Confederation philosophy, I invite you to join us. Those who come always report that it is a wonderful experience to be among a compatible and interesting group of people who have in common their interest in The Law of One.

The LOOP: We also wish to thank Lorena L., a friend of and volunteer for L/L Research. Lorena is offering a remarkable service replying to the handwritten correspondence sent in by seekers of truth in prison. She gives a warmhearted and thorough reply to each of their letters, offering loving guidance when requested and always the comfort of having a caring other to correspond with. “Our group meets once a month, usually on a Sunday, we spend part of our time reading parts of 'Law of One' material, or some of the Q'uo transcripts.
